Please stop by the office to pick up your 2011 directory during office hours.

**ATTENTION RESIDENTS**

To protect yourselves, please use licensed and insured contractors per the prospectus. It might be a good idea for you to know the background of anyone you invite onto your home site for any reason. You are responsible for the conduct of persons you invite into the community.

**RENT IS DUE ON THE 1<sup>st</sup> of EACH MONTH**

Remember, your rent is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. Late fees begin accruing after the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the month. To avoid late fees, please have your rent in the office by the 1<sup>st</sup>. If you have any questions, please refer to your prospectus. Automatic debit from your checking account is available, just call our office.

**Application for Residency, Occupancy of Homes, and Renters**

Some residents have allowed friends and family to live in their home without proper authorization. All potential residents must fill out our application for residency, have orientation with our office, pass a background check and be in good standing with our rules and regulations. One person in the home must be age 55 or over with other occupants being a minimum age of 40. There are some exceptions to this rule with management approval. This rule includes residents who rent their homes and the persons renting them. Anyone who will be renting your home may do so for a **minimum of six (6) months and must comply with the above.** Please do not jeopardize the tenancy of yourself and your home by not complying. We do keep an up to date HUD census in our office with copies of identification as residents move in and out of our community.

**ESTATE SALES OR MOVING SALES**

The management office permits these sales with certain restrictions. The ad you place in any media must be with the stipulation that it is "by appointment only" with your telephone number. The person(s) in attendance of the sale must have the ad in their position for admittance through the gate. YOU **MUST CONTACT THE MANAGEMENT OFFICE FOR APPROVAL**, two weeks prior to the ad being published for the sale. Garage Sales are **NOT** allowed.

**USE OF OUR FACILITIES**

The clubhouse and its facilities are for the enjoyment of all Crane Lakes' residents. The personal property provided by Crane Lakes is purchased and maintained for the community as a whole. If you would like to use specialized personal property in the Clubhouse, you may do so at your own expense. Any additional property brought into the facility and left for future use, must be approved by management. Management assumes no responsibility or liability for the personal property supplied by the residents.

**LAWN PROBLEM?**

Please contact our office as soon as possible if you see a problem with your lawn. We are doing the lawn treatment in-house as of this summer so we have tremendously improved our response times to these issues.

#### **Health Matters Article- 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Halifax- Health Hospice 5k/10k Run and Walk**

On Sunday, September 18<sup>th</sup> Halifax Health- Hospice will celebrate the spirit of care giving with the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual 5k/10K Run and Walk at City Center Complex in Port Orange. This much anticipated event raises funds for the Family Caregiver Program, which provides one-on-one care for patients and entitles caregivers too much needed respite time.

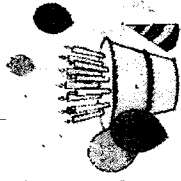
